Should the case be dismissed upon its merits, Plaintiff shall pay Defendant's reasonable expenses incurred in or in connection with this litigation, including costs and attorney's fees.

It is further ordered that the Clerk of the Court shall refuse the filing of any litigation presented by Michael E. Geiger, TDCJ-ID No. 577721 unless he obtains an order from the local administrative judge permitting the filing.
