DISBURSEMENT OF ACCESS TO JUSTICE CONTRIBUTIONS FROM THE STATE BAR OF TEXAS ANNUAL DUES STATEMENTS

ORDERED that:

Based on the Texas Access to Justice Commission's recommendation, which was in turn based on reports and recommendations from the State Bar of Texas, the Texas Bar Foundation, and the Texas Access to Justice Foundation, the State Bar of Texas and the Clerk of the Court shall disburse access to justice contributions from the State Bar of Texas annual dues statements deposited in the State Bar of Texas Access to Justice Account as follows:

- 1. a total of \$150,000 to the Texas Bar Foundation, of which amount:
- a. \$50,000 is designated for a grant to the South Texas Pro Bono Asylum Representation Project (ProBAR);
- b. \$20,000 is designated for the Access to Justice Summer Internship Program to provide stipends for participating law students;
 - c. \$80,000 is without designation;
- 2. the balance to the Texas Access to Justice Foundation, of which:
- a. \$20,000 is designated for the Texas Student Loan Repayment Assistance Program to match funds contributed by the State Bar of Texas for that Program;
 - b. the balance is without designation.
