## ORDER OF THE SUPREME COURT OF TEXAS

The \$76,350 allocated from the Judicial and Court Personnel Training Fund in this Court's order (Misc. Docket No. 92-0002) dated September 9, 1991 is granted to the School of Law of the University of Texas at Austin to be administered by the School of Law for the use of the Study Committee on Judicial and Court Personnel Education Programs, established and appointed by this Court's order (Misc. Docket No. 92-0001) dated September 9, 1991.

The members of the Study Committee are hereby authorized to be reimbursed for their actual necessary and reasonable expenses for transportation, meals, lodging, and incidental expenses either inside or outside the State of Texas and a consultant fee of up to \$200 a day while traveling on the business of the Committee.

The Study Committee is authorised, and the School of Law is authorized to disburse, funds hereby granted to employ necessary staff as determined by the Committee, to pay staff salaries, fringe benefits, operating expenses, other necessary expenses of the Committee, and staff travel at the rates provided by the General Appropriations Act for state employees, and for outside consultant fees and expenses as rates determined by the Committee and approved by the Court.

This order supersedes this Court's order (Misc. Docket No. 92-0014) dated November 13, 1991.
