ORDER AMENDING RULE IX(f),
RULES GOVERNING ADMISSION TO THE BAR OF TEXAS


IT IS ORDERED that Rule IX(f), *Rules Governing Admission to the Bar of Texas*, is amended as follows:


(f) ~~Any Applicant who fails a Texas Bar Examination may take a later examination upon filing a Re-application and payment of the then required fees by January 15, for the February Examination, and by June 15, for the July Examination, unless another provision of these Rules requires the filing of a Supplemental Investigation Form, in which case the Applicant must comply with the regular Application deadlines. Late fees shall be waived for any Re-applicant filing between the timely deadline and the Re-application deadline, if such Re-applicant took and failed the most recent examination given. The filing deadlines and applicability of late fees set out in subsection (a) of this rule shall not apply to Re-applicants who failed the immediately preceding Texas Bar Examination and therefore could not have met the subsection (a) deadlines. Any such Re-applicant may take the next examination given upon filing a Re-application, paying the required fees, and filing a Supplemental Investigation Form (if required by these Rules) by:~~

November 30, for the February Examination; or
May 30, for the July Examination.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT all other provisions of Rule XI are unaffected by this order, which shall be effective immediately.






