I certify that I have graduated from The University of Mississippi School of Law, a law school accredited by the American Bar Association, and have not failed the Texas Bar examination three or more times.

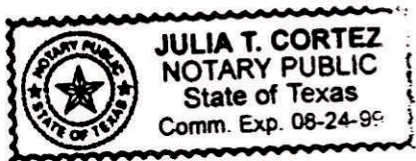
I further certify that I have not been disciplined for professional misconduct by the Bar or courts of any jurisdiction within the past ten years.
