DISCIPLINARY PETITION

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Comes now, Petitioner, COMMISSION FOR LAWYER DISCIPLINE, a committee of the State Bar of Texas, complaining of Respondent, EDWARD N. DANERI, and in support thereof would respectfully show the Court the following:

Parties

Petitioner is the COMMISSION FOR LAWYER DISCIPLINE, a committee of the State Bar of Texas. Respondent, EDWARD N. DANERI, Texas State Bar Number 05352900, is an attorney licensed to practice law in the State of Texas and is a member of the State Bar of Texas. Respondent is a resident of Bexar County, Texas. Respondent may be served with citation and a copy of this petition by serving him at his place of business located at 115 E. Travis, Suite 1105 San Antonio, Texas 78205-1605.

<u>Venue</u>

Respondent's principal place of law practice is in Bexar County, Texas. Accordingly, pursuant to Texas Rules of Disciplinary Procedure 3.03, venue is proper in Bexar County, Texas.

I.

Petitioner brings this disciplinary action pursuant to State Bar Act, Tex. Gov't. Code Ann., Sec. 81.001, et seq. (Vernon 1988), the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct and the Texas Rules of Disciplinary Procedure. The complaint which forms the basis of this action was filed on or about December 15, 1997. The acts and conduct of Respondent, as hereinafter alleged, constitute professional misconduct.

II.

- 1. On May 22, 1997, an Agreed Judgment of Fully Probated Suspension was entered into by and between the District 10A Grievance Committee and Respondent, Edward N. Daneri. Pursuant to the express terms of said Judgment, Respondent agreed to accept a two-year suspension from the practice of law beginning June 1, 1997 and ending June 1, 1999. The aforementioned suspension was fully probated on the condition that Respondent comply with certain terms and conditions to which Respondent had agreed. A true and correct copy of the Judgment is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein for all purposes.
- 2. Among the conditions of probation was the requirement that Respondent pay restitution to the Complainant, Gregorio Cisneros, in the amount of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00). The restitution amount was to be paid out in fifteen (15) installments of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) each beginning on August 1, 1997, with each succeeding payment due on the first day of each month until paid in full. Payments were to be in the form of a certified or cashier's check

and sent to the State Bar of Texas, 425 Soledad, Suite 300, San Antonio, Texas 78205.

- 3. On or about August 4, 1997, Respondent paid the first installment of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) directly to Complainant, Gregorio Cisnero. A true and correct copy of the money order, along with the receipt of funds, is attached hereto as **Exhibit B** and incorporated herein for all purposes.
- 4. Following the August 4, 1997 payment of the initial installment, Respondent failed to make any further payments towards the restitution ordered and agreed to under the Judgment. A True and correct copy of the Affidavit of Tina Gilson is attached hereto as **Exhibit C** and incorporated herein for all purposes.
- 5. As of the filing of this Disciplinary Petition with the Supreme Court of Texas, Respondent has defaulted on restitution payments for the period of September 1, 1997 through October 1, 1998, totaling Twenty-Six Thousand Dollars (\$26,000.00).

III.

The conduct of Respondent described above constitutes a violation of the following Texas

Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct:

Rule 8.04(a)(1) -- A lawyer shall not violate these rules, * * * *.

Rule 8.04(a)(7) -- A lawyer shall not violate any disciplinary or disability order or judgment.

PRAYER

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, Petitioner prays that a judgment of professional misconduct be entered against Respondent imposing an appropriate sanction as the facts shall warrant and that Petitioner have such other relief to which it is entitled, including costs of court and attorney's fees.

As a practical matter, I would respectfully suggest that you inquire with the judge to be appointed as to: (1) whether he or she will be able to comply with the 180 day deadline by which the case must be set for trial as set forth in Section 3.07 of the Texas Rules of Disciplinary Procedure; and (2) whether he or she can accommodate compliance with Mellon Service Co., et al v. Touche Ross Co., 946 S.W.2d 862 (Tex.App.- Houston [14th Dist.] 1997), which requires that all proceedings incident to a case occur in the county of proper venue. If not, I would respectfully request that an alternate appointment be made.

Once a trial judge has been appointed, please forward the original and three (3) copies of the Disciplinary Petition, the filing fee check, also enclosed herewith, and the Court's appointing order to the District Clerk of Bexar County, Texas, with the request that the suit be filed, service be obtained, and a filemarked copy of the petition returned to the undersigned.
