ORDER AMENDING RULE XI(f),

RULES GOVERNING ADMISSION TO THE BAR OF TEXAS

IT IS ORDERED that XI(f), Rules Governing Admission to the Bar of Texas, is amended as follows:

f. An Applicant may take no more than five (5) examinations. However, for good cause shown, the Board at its discretion may waive this limitation upon such conditions as the Board may prescribe.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT all other provisions of Rule XI are unaffected by this order, which shall be effective immediately.
