- 1.) Parties must pay or make arrangements to pay for the record **unless** indigent. TRAP 20.2 (Criminal) and TRCP 145 (Civil).
- 2.) If a designation is not filed, the clerk is required to prepare a record according to TRAP 34.5(a).
- 3.) If the defendant is the appellant, the trial court clerk's record **MUST** include the trial court's certification of the defendant's right of appeal. **(CRIMINAL CASES ONLY)** TRAP 25.2(d).
- 4.) An information form is available on the website that we request the clerk send along with the copy of the notice of appeal. TRAP 25.1(f) and 25.2 (e).
- 5.) If you need additional time to prepare your record you will need to request an extension of time. Reporters extensions require a copy of their monthly report pursuant to TRAP 13.4.
