






Redaction Utilization

- Redaction was soft-launched in January
- Solution has been utilized over 128k times since January
- Average utilization is over 14k per month
- Implemented by 3 EFSPs
 - eFileTexas
 - > FileTime
 - > ProDoc
- Communication outreach plan to promote tool's availability began in May




