Report from the Texas Indigent Defense Commission (TIDC) for the February 24, 2023 Texas Judicial **Council Meeting**

TIDC Board and Committee Meetings

On October 26, the TIDC Geoffrey Burkhart board met to discuss the Texas Judicial Council's legislative proposal related to family protection legal representation and TIDC. The Policy and Standards (P&S) Committee met on November 9 to finalize recommendations for the upcoming legislative session. The TIDC Full Board



met on December 1 for updates from the P&S Committee. The next board meeting is on March 30, 2023 at 10:00 a.m. in the 1st floor conference room in the Tom C. Clark building.

TIDC at the Texas Legislature

On September 27, Geoff testified on TIDC's Legislative Appropriations Request (LAR) at the Joint Budget hearing for the LBB. On October 3, Geoff and Linda Gonzalez testified at the Joint Hearing: Judiciary & Civil Jurisprudence and Juvenile Justice & Family Issues on the



interim charge related to the Texas-Mexico border. On November 15, Geoff was invited to testify at the Senate Border Security Committee hearing on the interim charge related to the Texas-Mexico border with Megan LaVoie. TIDC submitted its revised LAR in late January.

Staff Update

In addition to its normal monitoring, grants administration, and data collection, TIDC staff has been involved in the following:

- Sarah Gammell, PhD. joined the TIDC staff as our first ever Research Director, Eric Schneider joined as our new Grants Specialist, and Donovan Estrada joins us as this semester's intern from the Texas Tech University School of Law.
- TIDC staff has traveled to Goliad, Kleberg, Willacy, Galveston, Kaufman, Van Zandt, Franklin, Rains, Wharton, Bee, and Live Oak Counties for fiscal or policy monitoring visits.
- TIDC staff has issued final fiscal monitoring reports for <u>Kinney</u> and <u>Karnes</u> Counties.
- TIDC staff presented at several conferences and workshops, including the <u>National Association</u>



for Public Defense (NAPD) Women's Virtual Conference, the <u>Texas Association of Court</u> <u>Administration (TACA)</u>, the Galveston County Criminal Justice Coordinating Council, Texas Justice Courts Training Center's Magistration Workshop, the Criminal Justice Planners meeting, the <u>Judicial Summit on Mental Health</u>, the UT School of Law Children's Rights Clinic, and the <u>National Association for Public Defense (NAPD)</u> <u>Leadership Institute</u> at the Texas Capitol.
