**ORDER FINDING PLAINTIFF
TANENANKHAHA ANDREWS A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT**

On this day came to be heard Defendants Homecomings Financial Network Inc., Christopher Gilson, Davee L. Olson, Mortgage Electronic Registrations Services, Jack O'Boyle, Russell Stockman, Shelly Ortolani, JP Morgan Chase Bank as Trustee (erroneously named by Plaintiff as JPMorgan Chase Bank), William B. Harrison, Jr., Dina Dublon, and Sandra Morales's (collectively, "Defendants") Request for Anti-Suit Injunction and Order Finding Plaintiff a Vexatious Litigant. The Court finds that Defendants' Request is meritorious and should be granted. Defendants' Request for Anti-Suit Injunction and Order Finding Plaintiff a Vexatious Litigant is, therefore, GRANTED.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Plaintiff Tanenankhaha Andrews, also known as Kaiser Bernard Ford III, is a vexatious litigant and that Plaintiff cannot file a lawsuit without first obtaining the permission of the local administrative judge where Plaintiff intends to file suit.
