Came to be heard Defendants' Motion for a Pre-Filing Order, and the Court having first declared Plaintiff Solis to be a vexatious litigant pursuant to the procedures set forth in TEX. CIV. PRAC. & REM. CODE Chapter 11, is of the opinion that the following order shall issue:

It is ORDERED that Mr. Arturo Solis is hereby prohibited from filing, *in propria persona*, any new litigation in a court of this State without first obtaining permission from a local administrative judge pursuant to TEX. CIV. PRAC. & REM. CODE § 11.102. If Plaintiff Solis does file new litigation in violation of this order, that suit will be subject to dismissal and Plaintiff Solis will be subject to sanctions as proscribed by TEX. CIV. PRAC. & REM. CODE § 11.101(b).
