**ORDER ON DEFENDANT STATE OF TEXAS' MOTION TO DECLARE
PLAINTIFF CORDELL MOODY A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT,
STAY THE PROCEEDINGS AND REQUEST FOR SECURITY**

After considering *Defendant State of Texas' Motion To Declare Plaintiff Cordell Moody A Vexatious Litigant, Stay The Proceedings And Request For Security*, the Court hereby **GRANTS** the motion and declares plaintiff Cordell Moody a vexatious litigant.

Plaintiff Cordell Moody is required to post \$2,000 with the District Clerk as security per the section 11.055 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code within 30 days of this order. The court stays the proceedings until such security is posted. If security is not timely posted, this case shall be *dismissed* pursuant to section 11.056 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code.

Furthermore, the Court prohibits the Plaintiff Cordell Moody from filing any new lawsuits *in propria persona* in any court Texas until he receives permission from the local administrative judge pursuant to sections 11.101 and 11.102 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code.
