

ORDER DECLARING PLANTIFF A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT

The Court, having heard the Defendant on its Motion to Declare Plaintiff a Vexatious Litigant, finds that Defendant is a Vexatious litigant, pursuant to Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code s§ 11.051 et seq. Further, the court finds Plaintiff's suit against Defendant "frivolous and brought for the purpose of abusing judicial resources," pursuant to Texas Government Code § 498.0045. It is therefore ORDERED that a copy of this Order be forwarded to the Texas Department of Criminal Justice for the purpose of forfeiture of Plaintiff's good conduct time, pursuant to § 498.0045.

It is, therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED that Plaintiff is prohibited from filing any new lawsuits in any court in Texas until Plaintiff receives permission from the local administrative judge pursuant to sections 11.101 and 11.102 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code.
