
**ORDER ON DEFENDANT TIMOLYN SMITH'S MOTION TO DECLARE
PLAINTIFF SANDRA CRENSHAW, A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT,
STAY THE PROCEEDINGS AND REQUEST FOR SECURITY**

After considering Defendant's Motion to declare Plaintiff a Vexatious Litigant, Stay the Proceedings, and Request for Security, the response and argument of counsel, the Court hereby GRANTS the motion and declares the Plaintiff Sandra Crenshaw, a Vexatious Litigant.

Plaintiff is required to post \$7,500 with the District Clerk, as security for the benefit of the moving Defendant per section 11.055 of the Texas Civil Practices and Remedies Code within 30 days of this order. Security is an undertaking by the Plaintiff to assure payment to the moving Defendant of the moving Defendant's reasonable expenses incurred in or in connection with litigation commenced, caused to be commenced, maintained or caused to be maintained by the Plaintiff, including costs and attorney's fees. If security is not timely posted, the case shall be dismissed pursuant to section 11.056 of the Texas Civil Practices and Remedies Code.

Furthermore, this Court prohibits the Plaintiff from filing any new lawsuits *in propria persona* in any Texas Court until the Plaintiff receives permission from the local administrative judge pursuant to sections 11.101 and 11.102 of the Texas Civil Practices and Remedies Code.
