FINAL JUDGMENT

On this day, the Court came to hear Texas Workforce Commission's Plea to the Jurisdiction, Motion to Dismiss, and Motion to Declare Plaintiff a Vexatious Litigant. Having considered the pleadings, evidence, and arguments of the parties, the Court finds that Plaintiff Wayne Boyd failed to properly comply with the statutory prerequisites for bringing a suit for judicial review against the Texas Workforce Commission substantial evidence and consequently has deprived the Court of subject matter jurisdiction over this cause of action. The Court further finds that Plaintiff's claims have been previously been adjudicated by a court of competent jurisdiction and are likewise barred by the doctrine of res judicata. The Court additionally finds that Plaintiff Wayne Boyd is a vexatious litigant.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the plea to the jurisdiction and motion to dismiss are granted and that all of Plaintiff Wayne Boyd's claims in this cause of action are dismissed with prejudice against refiling same.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff Wayne Boyd is declared a vexatious litigant pursuant to section 11.054 of the Texas Civil Practices & Remedies Code.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff Wayne Boyd is prohibited from filing new litigation in any court in this State without obtaining prior permission from the local administrative judge pursuant to sections 11.101 and 11.102 of the Texas Civil Practices & Remedies Code.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of this Court shall forward a copy of this order to the Office of Court Administration pursuant to section 11.104 of the Texas Civil Practices & Remedies Code.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all costs of court shall be borne by the party incurring same and that all other relief not herein granted is denied.
