ORDER

Having considered the Defendant's Motion To Declare Plaintiff A Vexatious Litigant Under Chapter 11, Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code as well as all evidence and argument presented by the parties, the Court finds that the motion should be and is hereby granted, and Plaintiff is declared a vexatious litigant.

Due to Plaintiff's status as an indigent party, Plaintiff is ORDERED to furnish security in the amount of only \$100, which is insufficient to assure payment to defendant of defendant's reasonable expenses incurred in or in connection with this litigation commenced by the plaintiff, including costs and attorney's fees. This cause is STAYED until Plaintiff furnishes the security required; however, Plaintiff's claims shall be dismissed if Plaintiff does not furnish the security required within 30 days of the date of this Order.


Plaintiff is PROHIBITED from filing, pro se, a new litigation in a court of this state without permission of the appropriate local administrative judge to file the litigation, as described by and pursuant to Section 11.102, Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code.
