**ORDER DETERMINING PLAINTIFF CRAIG WHITE
A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT AND REQUESTING SECURITY**

On this date, the Court considered Defendant's Motion to Declare Plaintiff Craig White a vexatious litigant and requesting security, as well as the pleadings in the above-styled and numbered cause. After considering said motion and arguments of counsel, the Court opinion is as follows:

The Court finds Plaintiff Craig White is a vexatious litigant pursuant to Section 11.054 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code. Plaintiff is hereby ordered to furnish security in the amount of 5,000.00 by May 15, 2017, to proceed in this case. Failure to timely furnish security will result in dismissal of this suit.

Pursuant to Section 11.101 of the Civil Practice and Remedies Code, the Court further orders that Plaintiff be subject to this Pre-filing Order, prohibiting him from filing, pro se, new litigation in any court of this State without permission from a local administrative judge in each new litigation. If Plaintiff does file new litigation in violation of this order, that suit will be subject to dismissal, and Plaintiff will be subject to sanctions as proscribed by Section 11.101(b) of the Civil Practice and Remedies Code. The clerk shall forward a copy of this Order to the Office of Court Administration in accordance to Section 11.104 of the Civil Practice and Remedies Code.
