**ORDER ON DEFENDANTS' MOTION TO DECLARE
PLAINTIFF CHIOMA OKORO A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT**


On April 15, 2019, the Court heard Defendants' Motion to Declare Plaintiff Chioma Okoro a Vexatious Litigant (filed on March 27, 2019). Having considered the motion, the Court's file, the evidence and the arguments presented, the Court hereby GRANTS the motion and ORDERS the following:

- (1) Plaintiff Chioma Okoro is declared a vexatious litigant pursuant to Chapter 11 of the Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code.
- (2) Pursuant to Section 11.055 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code, Plaintiff Chioma Okoro must deposit into the registry of the Court \$15,000.00 by April 30, 2019 (which is 14 days from the date of this order). If Plaintiff fails to deposit this security by the date set in this order, the Court will dismiss the litigation as to all defendants pursuant to Section 11.056 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code.
- (3) Pursuant to Section 11.101 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code, Plaintiff Chioma Okoro is prohibited from filing, pro se, new litigation in a court to which this order applies without seeking and obtaining the permission of (a) the local administrative judge of the type of court in which she intends to file or (b) the local

administrative district judge of the county in which she intends to file, if she intends to file in a justice or constitutional county court.

- (4) The Clerk of this Court shall provide a copy of this order to the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System.
