# **ORDER DECLARING AMY MING A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT**

On SEPTEMBER 2, 2020, the Court considered the Motion to Have Amy Ming Declared a Vexatious Litigant filed by BRITTANY MING in this case and cause number.

# **Appearance**

Movant, BRITTANY MING, appeared in person and through attorney of record, ANTHONY ROBLES, and announced ready.

Respondent, AMY MING, after receiving notice of this hearing did not appear and wholly made default.

### Jurisdiction

All parties entitled to citation and notice were served and noticed and the Court has the jurisdiction over the persons and the subject matter of the Motion.

#### Record

A record of the proceedings was made by the official court reporter for the 446<sup>th</sup> Judicial District of Ector County, Texas.

#### Order

After considering the pleadings, evidence, and arguments of counsel, IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. That there is no reasonable probability that AMY MING will prevail in the litigation against BRITTANY MING in this case and cause number.
- 2. AMY MING is declared a vexatious litigant under Tex.Civ.Prac. & Rem. Code § 11.054(2)(A) because the divorce matter in the case and cause number was finally resolved pursuant to an entry of an order entitled *Final Decree of Divorce*, which was signed on JANUARY 22, 2020 and AMY MING continues to repeatedly relitigate the validity of the determination as to whom this litigation was finally determined.
- 3. AMY MING is declared a vexatious litigant under Tex.Civ.Prac. & Rem. Code § 11.054(2)(B) because the divorce matter in the case and cause number was finally resolved pursuant to an entry of an order entitled *Final Decree of Divorce*, which was signed on JANUARY 22, 2020 and the cause of action, claim, controversy, or any of the issues of fact or law determined or concluded by the final determination against AMY MING.
- 4. AMY MING shall post security with the Court in the amount of \$10,000.00 via cashier's check or money on or before SEPTEMBER 23, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. for the benefit of BRITTANY MING to provide security that AMY

MING will undertake her pending actions in this case and cause number to assure payment to BRITTANY MING of the reasonable expenses incurred in or in connection with the litigation commenced, caused to be commenced, maintained, or caused to be maintained by AMY MING, including costs and attorney's fees.

- 5. If AMY MING fails to furnish the security in strict conformity with the order to provide security above, all matters currently pending in this case and cause number and filed by AMY MING in this case and cause number shall be dismissed with prejudice effective **SEPTEMBER 24, 2020 at 8:00 a.m.**
- 6. AMY MING is prohibited from filing, pro se, new litigation, in any court within the State of Texas without the permission of the appropriate local administrative judge.
- 7. Any clerk of any court of the State of Texas, upon receipt of this order shall reject any new litigation filed by AMY MING without the permission of the appropriate local administrative judge.
- 8. The Court's Clerk shall refuse to accept any and all pro se documents sought to be filed by AMY MING without the permission of the appropriate local administrative judge which seek affirmative relief. Currently, the local administrative judge for Ector County, Texas is as follows:
