PREFILING ORDER

On September 16, 2021, the Court considered the *Defendant Department of Family and Protective Services's Motion for Order Declaring Petitioner, Denley Bishop, A Vexations Litigant and Requiring Security*. The Court finds that Petitioner, Denley Bishop, is a vexatious litigant pursuant to Section 11.054 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code, and the Court having first declared Denley Bishop to be a vexatious litigant pursuant to the procedures set forth in the Texas Civil Practices and Remedies Code, Chapter 11, is of the opinion that the following order shall issue:

IT IS ORDERED that Defendant's Motion is, in all things, **GRANTED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner, Denley Bishop, is hereby prohibited from filing, *in propria persona or pro se*, any new litigation, or filing into any existing cause number, concerning the children [REDACTED] or [REDACTED] [REDACTED] in any Court of Cooke County pursuant to Texas Civil Practices and Remedies Code §11.102. If Petitioner does file new litigation in violation of this order, that suit will be subject to dismissal and Petitioner will be subject to sanctions as proscribed by Texas Civil Practices and Remedies Code §11.101(b).

Further pursuant to Texas Civil Practices and Remedies Code §11.104, the Clerk of this Court is **ORDERED** to provide a copy of this **ORDER** to the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System (OCA) within 30 days so it may be recorded with the State List of Vexatious Litigants.
