At its April 22, 2022 quarterly meeting commissioners voted unanimously to dismiss the referenced complaint for the following reasons: 1) the complaint's allegations concerned the patient's sexual history as opposed to the SANE's examination of physical evidence; 2) the record is ambiguous regarding the alleged victim's statement; and 3) Commission staff's communication with the SANE indicated she agreed her testimony may have led to confusion and is willing to provide clarification if requested by the parties.
