MEMORANDUM OPINION

This is an appeal from a judgment signed June 27, 2000.

On February 21, 2001, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss the appeal because the case has been settled. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1. The parties ask that we vacate the trial court's judgment, dismiss the appeal, and release any and all sureties from liability for any judgment arising from this action. The motion is granted.

Accordingly, we vacate the trial court's judgment and order the appeal dismissed. We order that the supersedeas bond filed by appellants be released to appellants wholly intact and without execution by appellee and we order that the sureties designated within the

supersedeas bond filed by appellants be fully and finally released from all liability arising from any judgment entered in this action.
