
It is hereby ORDERED that said Motion is GRANTED. Plaintiff Rob L. Newby (a.k.a. Robbie Lynn Newby), TDCJ-ID No. 1238216 is hereby DETERMINED TO BE A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT.

THEREFORE, Plaintiff is ordered to furnish security in the amount of \$2000.00. The amount must be furnished to the Court by March 19, 2008. Should Plaintiff fail to furnish such security within the time set by this Order, the above referenced and numbered cause is DISMISSED. Should the case be dismissed upon its merits, Plaintiff shall pay Defendant's reasonable expenses incurred in or in connection with this litigation, including costs and attorney's fees.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall refuse the filing of any litigation presented by Rob L. Newby (a.k.a. Robbie Lynn Newby), TDCJ-ID No. 1238216 unless he obtains an order from the local administrative judge permitting the filing.

It is also FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall forward a copy of this Order to the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System in accordance with Section 11.104(a) of the Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code.
