It is **ORDERED** that Defendants motion is hereby **GRANTED**. Plaintiff is hereby declared a vexatious litigant pursuant to TEX. CIV. PRAC. & REM. CODE Chapter 11.

It is **FURTHER ORDERED** that Plaintiff shall **FURNISH SECURITY** in the amount of \$ 10,000 no later than 17th, 2012. As explained in TEX. CIV. PRAC. & REM. CODE § 11.055, this "security is an undertaking by the plaintiff to assure payment to the moving defendants of their reasonable expenses incurred in or in connection with a litigation commenced, caused to be commenced, maintained, or caused to be maintained by the plaintiff, including costs and attorney's fees."

PRE-FILING ORDER

Came to be heard **Defendants Robert Quada's Motion to Declare Plaintiff Robert Troy McClure a Vexatious Litigant**, and the Court having first declared Plaintiff Robert Troy McClure to be a vexatious litigant pursuant to the procedures set forth in TEX. CIV. PRAC. & REM. CODE Chapter 11, is of the opinion that the following order shall issue:

It is **ORDERED** that Mr. ~~Arturo Solis~~ ^{Robert Troy McClure} is hereby prohibited from filing, *in propria persona*, any new litigation in a court of this State without first obtaining permission from a local administrative judge pursuant to TEX. CIV. PRAC. & REM. CODE § 11.102. If Plaintiff Robert Troy McClure does file new litigation in violation of this order, that suit will be subject to dismissal and Plaintiff Robert Troy McClure will be subject to sanctions as proscribed by TEX. CIV. PRAC. & REM. CODE § 11.101(b).
