
Gentlemen:


- 1. I am not in possession of any Texas Bar cards or certificates.

If there is anything further which you require, please let me know.





As of this date, I have requested that the Chief Disciplinary Counsel issue to you a letter or certificate of good standing. A copy of that letter is enclosed.


