Dear Chief Justice Phillips:

This Friday our Court will be in Houston to hear arguments in the remaining cases which were transferred to us in 1991. We have one case which was 14-91-00303-CV and is 08-91-00137-CV on our docket, styled Sheldon L. Pollack, Trust of 1982, John P. Pollack and Eileen Pollack Erickson v. Loraine McMurrey still pending. That case cannot be set because of a proceeding in bankruptcy by one of the parties. Since it will be the only remaining case, we request it be transferred back to the 14th Court of Appeals.

In the recent transfer of cases from the Dallas Court of Appeals, we received what is now 08-92-00199-CR styled Terry Earl Hall v. The State of Texas. A companion case 06-92-00042-CR is now on the docket in Texarkana. His counsel, Ross Teter, has suggested these cases should be consolidated in one court. Chief Justice William Cornelius and I have agreed to transfer his case to our Court.

It is requested that these two transfers be made by your Court.

I just noticed that the appeals filed by Terry Earl Hall have been forwarded to two different Courts of Appeal. The appeal filed in the 6th District is a plea of guilty and a motion to proceed with adjudication. The appeal filed in the 8th District is a conviction on a plea of guilty to the offense that was alleged as grounds for the motion to proceed with adjudication.

It appears to me that it might be preferable if one Court hears both appeals. I have no objection to any such action and I shall forward a copy of this letter to counsel for the State in order for that office to be able to advise you whether there is any objection to consolidating the two appeals.
