**ORDER ON RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO DECLARE PETITIONER
 A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT**

After considering Respondents', AYLENE SHAIKH, YASSER SHAIKH, JUNAID SHAIKH, and NICOLA SHAIKH, *Motion to Declare Petitioner, ZIA SHAIKH, a Vexatious Litigant*, Petitioner's response (if any), the evidence presented at the hearing, and the arguments of counsel, the Court:

GRANTS the motion, declares Petitioner a vexatious litigant, and orders as follows:

1. Petitioner must furnish security for the benefit of Respondents, AYLENE SHAIKH, YASSER SHAIKH, JUNAID SHAIKH, and NICOLA SHAIKH, by posting a surety bond with the court clerk in the amount of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) by December 16, 2019. The security is to assure payment to the Respondents for reasonable expenses, including their court costs and attorney fees, should the case be resolved adversely to Petitioner.

2. If Petitioner does not furnish security within the time limit set by this order, the Court will dismiss this suit with prejudice against Petitioner.

3. This suit will remain in abatement until Petitioner complies with this order or until it is dismissed by further order of this Court.

4. Petitioner must not file as a *pro se* party any new litigation in a court in Texas against any party without first obtaining permission from the appropriate local administrative judge as required by Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code section 11.102(a).

5. As required by Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code section 11.104, the court clerk will provide a copy of this order to the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System.
