This suit will remain in abatement until plaintiff complies with this order or until it is dismissed by further order of this Court.

Plaintiff must not file as a pro se party any new litigation in a court in Texas against any party, the defendant and its agents, directors, officers, employees, heirs, assigns without first obtaining permission from the appropriate local administrative judge as required by Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code section 11.102(a).

As required by Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code section 11.104, the court clerk will provide a copy of this order to the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System.
