

PRE-FILING ORDER

The Court, having first declared Plaintiff Lee A. Hamilton to be a vexatious litigant pursuant to the procedures set forth in Texas Civil Practices and Remedies Code Chapter 11, is of the opinion that the following order shall issue:

It is **ORDERED** that Plaintiff is prohibited from filing any new litigation in a court of this State without first obtaining permission from a local administrative judge pursuant to Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code § 11.102. If Plaintiff does file new litigation in violation of this order, that suit will be subject to dismissal and Plaintiff will be subject to sanctions as allowed by Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code § 11.101(b).


Further, pursuant to Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code § 11.104, the **CLERK of this Court is ORDERED** to provide a copy of this Order to the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System (OCA) within 30 days so that it may be recorded with the State List of Vexatious Litigants.
