The Second Court of Appeals in Fort Worth is now accepting applications for a deputy clerk position. (Posting #22-003.) Applications will be accepted until the position is filled.

Work involves maintaining records and filing, tracking, and managing cases filed in an appellate court. Minimum qualifications include a high-school diploma; college courses are a plus. Applicants must be computer literate, with experience in Windows, Microsoft Word, and Adobe Acrobat. Excellent typing, reading, spelling, and grammar skills are required. Applicants must be extremely detail-oriented, and prior court clerk experience in appellate case management is strongly preferred.

The State job title is Deputy Clerk III or IV, with a minimum annual salary of \$45,000; starting salary may increase, depending upon the applicant's experience and subject to State guidelines. The position is full-time (40-hour work week, Monday through Friday, 8 a.m.–5 p.m.). Vacation, sick leave, health and dental insurance, retirement, and other benefits are provided in accordance with State policy.
