ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO DECLARE PLAINTIFF A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT & REOUEST FOR SECURITY

On May 26, 2023, the Court examined the Defendants' motion to declare Plaintiff, Shamelya Etier, a vexatious litigant, Plaintiff's response, the evidence presented at the hearing, the pleadings on file with the Court, and the arguments of counsel, the Court GRANTS the motion declares plaintiff a vexatious litigant, and IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. Plaintiff must furnish security for the benefit of defendants, Shahnoor Chisti and Nahid Parvin-Chisti, by tendering cash with the court clerk in the amount of \$2,500.00 by June 9, 2023. The security is to assure payment to the defendant for reasonable expenses, including their court costs and attorney fees, should the case be dismissed on the merits.
- 2. If plaintiff does not furnish security within the time limit set by this order, the Court will dismiss this suit with prejudice against Plaintiff.
- 3. This suit will remain in abatement until Plaintiff complies with this order or until it is dismissed by further order of this Court.
- 4. Plaintiff must not file as a pro se party any new litigation in a court in Texas against any party without first obtaining permission from the appropriate local administrative judge as required by Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code Section 11.102(a).

5. As required by Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code Section 11.104, the court clerk will provide a copy of this order to the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System.
