After decades serving as a prosecutor, defense attorney, and Conviction Integrity Unit Chief, Dawn Moore Boswell joined the University of North Texas Health Science Center, Center for Human Identification (UNTCHI), as its Director of Legal Forensics & Training in 2019. Dawn now uses the knowledge, experience, and perspectives she gained in those roles to train analysts and stakeholders, establish best practices for forensics, and provide guidance on the increasingly critical intersection between science and the criminal justice system. She has played an important role in the oversight of forensic science — from developing and implementing forensic disclosure compliance procedures during her tenure with the Tarrant County Criminal District Attorney's Office, to frequently collaborating with the Texas Forensic Science Commission, to her most recent service on NIST's Expert Working Group on Human Factors and DNA analysis.
