## **DEPUTY CLERK**

Work involves filing, tracking, and managing cases filed in an appellate court; maintaining records archives; and communicating about cases with parties, counsel, the public, and other court personnel. Minimum qualifications include a high-school diploma; college courses are a plus. Applicants must be computer literate, with experience in Windows, Microsoft Word, and Adobe Acrobat. Excellent typing, reading, spelling, and grammar skills are required. Applicants must be extremely detail-oriented, and prior court clerk experience in appellate case management is strongly preferred.

The State job title is Deputy Clerk IV, with an annual salary range of \$45,244 to \$72,408, depending upon the applicant's skills and experience. The position is full-time (40-hour work week, Monday through Friday, 8 a.m.–5 p.m.).
