ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANTS' MOTION TO DECLARE PLAINTIFF A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT

On June 12, 2024, the Court heard Armbrust & Brown, PLLC, David King, Guillermo A. Alarcon, and Ali Arabzadegan's Motion to Declare Plaintiff a Vexatious Litigant ("Motion"). The Court finds Plaintiff Rickye Henderson is a vexatious litigant pursuant to section 11.054 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code. Plaintiff is hereby ORDERED to furnish security in the amount of \$30,000.00 (the "Required Security") by July 15, 2024, to proceed in the subject causes of action (the "Causes"). The Required Security is an undertaking by Plaintiff to assure payment to Defendants of their reasonable expenses anticipated to be incurred in or in connection with the subject Causes.

It is further ORDERED that, pursuant to section 11.052 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code, the subject Causes are and shall remain stayed, and Defendants are not required to plead, before the 10th day after the date Defendants receive written notice that Plaintiff has

furnished the Required Security. Failure by Plaintiff to timely furnish the Required Security shall result in dismissal of the Causes.

Pursuant to section 11.101 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code, the Court further ORDERS that Plaintiff be prohibited from filing, pro se, new litigation in any court in this State without permission from a local administrative judge in each new litigation. The clerk of the court shall forward a copy of this order to the Office of Court Administration pursuant to section 11.104 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code.
