Fourth Court of Appeals to Hear Oral Argument

The Fourth Court of Appeals will hear oral arguments in one appeal on Thursday, April 3, 2025, beginning at 9:00 a.m., before the following panel of justices: Chief Justice Rebeca C. Martinez, Justice Lori I. Valenzuela, and Justice Lori Massey Brissette.

The following appeal will be presented:

Christopher Luis Del Toro v. The State of Texas—This appeal arises from a trial in which a jury convicted Appellant of criminally negligent homicide and intoxicated manslaughter. In three appellate issues, Appellant challenges (1) the sufficiency of the probable cause affidavit used in applying for a warrant to draw his blood, (2) the application of the Texas Transportation Code to his blood draw, and (3) the trial court’s order allowing testimony relating to data obtained from the airbag control module of vehicle drive by him.

The oral argument will be held in the courtroom of the Fourth Court of Appeals, Caden-Reeves Justice Center, Third Floor, 300 Dolorosa, San Antonio, Texas. The argument can also be accessed using the following link.
