**ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO DECLARE PETITIONER
CHRISTOPHER WATKINS A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT AND
REQUEST FOR SECURITY**

On this day the Court considered Respondent's Motion to Declare Petitioner Christopher Watkins a Vexatious Litigant and Request for Security (the "Motion").

After considering the Motion, the pleadings, the evidence, and arguments presented by both parties, the Court is of the opinion that Respondent's Motion should be GRANTED and is in all things GRANTED.

IT IS ORDERED that Christopher Watkins is deemed a vexatious litigant as defined by Chapter 11 of the Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner Christopher Watkin must pay into the registry of this Court the amount of \$10,000.00 as security for costs within 30 days of this Order. If Petitioner Christopher Watkins does not furnish said security within such time, it is ordered that all of Petitioner Christopher Watkins' claims brought against Respondent Serena Watkins in the instant suit, or that could have been brought against Respondent Serena Watkins, shall be DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Christopher Watkins is prohibited from filing pro se, a new litigation in any Texas State court without advance permission of the local administrative judge of such court;

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that upon entry of this Order, the Clerk of this Court shall send a copy of this Order to the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System.
