



The Business Court of Texas is a specialized trial court with limited jurisdiction over business-related matters as established in section 25A.006 of the Texas Government Code. Jurisdiction is limited by subject matter and amount in controversy. The Business Court has ten judges: two each in the Austin, Dallas, Fort Worth, Houston, and San Antonio areas.

The Court accepts applications for temporary, one year Court Law Clerk II (Law Clerk) positions generally beginning in September and ending in August. Strong preference is given to candidates with outstanding academic records and demonstrated writing ability.

Law clerks assist the judge they work for by conducting legal research, studying briefs, preparing for hearings, and researching and drafting opinions.
