Fourth Court of Appeals to Hear Oral Argument

The Fourth Court of Appeals will hear oral argument in one appeal on Thursday, January 29, 2026, beginning at 10:00 a.m., before the following panel of justices: Justice Lori Massey Brissette, Justice Adrian A. Spears II, and Justice Velia J. Meza.

Pullen v. State, Appeal No. 04-24-00713-CR: In this appeal, Jacob Pullen appeals his conviction for seven counts of accessing with intent to view child pornography under Texas Penal Code § 43.26. The issues presented include the sufficiency of the evidence supporting the convictions and whether remote testimony by a federal agent, authorized under a *Touhy* letter, violated the Confrontation Clause.
