Order Declaring Jacob White a Vexatious Litigant

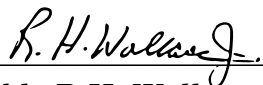
On July 8, 2026, the Court heard the City of Grapevine's motion to declare Jacob White a vexatious litigant. Based on the papers filed, the evidence presented and the arguments of the parties, the Court finds that Jacob White meets the criteria to be declared a vexatious litigant under Texas Civil Practices and Remedies Code Chapter 11. Therefore, the Court GRANTS the motion and ORDERS as follows:

1. Jacob White is declared a vexatious litigant for all purposes.
2. White is prohibited from filing, pro se, any new litigation in any court in this State without the written permission of the appropriate local administrative judge in the jurisdiction where White attempts to file such litigation. The local administrative judge may condition permission upon White furnishing security for the benefit of the defendant(s) or any other condition as provided under Chapter 11 of the Texas Civil Practices and Remedies Code.
3. If Jacob White violates this prefiling order, he will be subject to contempt of court in addition to the other remedies afforded under Chapter 11 of the Texas Civil Practices and Remedies Code.
4. Jacob White is to post security in the amount of \$10,000.00 within 30 days of the date of this Order. In the event Plaintiff fails to post security within 30 days, this case will be dismissed.

5. The Clerk of the Court is directed to notify the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System (“OCA”) of this Court’s declaration of Jacob White as a vexatious litigant by delivering a copy of this order to the OCA at the following address:
