ORDER

On this date, the Court considered Attorney General's Amicus Curiae Advisory to Declare Plaintiff Vexatious, Advisory Recommending Prefiling Order & Advisory Recommending Dismissal Pursuant to Chapter Fourteen and the pleadings filed in the above-referenced cause. The Court finds that Attorney General's Advisory should be, and hereby is, GRANTED. The Court finds Plaintiff Don Lang is a vexatious litigant pursuant to section 11.054 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code. Plaintiff is hereby ordered to furnish security in the amount of \$500 by May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2015 to proceed in this case. Failure to timely furnish security may result in dismissal of this suit.

Pursuant to section 11.101 of the Civil Practice and Remedies Code, the Court further orders that Plaintiff be prohibited from filing new litigation in any court in this State without permission from a local administrative judge in each new litigation. The clerk of the court shall forward a copy of this order to the Office of Court Administration pursuant to section 11.104 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code.
